Ministry Musings

"Jesus said to them again, 'Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you.' When he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, 'Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained.'" (John 20:21-23, NRSVue)

CHRIST IS RISEN! HE IS RISEN INDEED!

On that mysterious Easter morning, might our risen Jesus Christ have witnessed the Disciples' minds full of despair, anxiety, disappointment, and doubt? Even more, do you think our resurrected Jesus witnessed their faces full of delight, surprise, fear, maybe even horror?

I often think about how many hours the Disciples must have spent together with Jesus. I imagine that they spent every waking, resting, and sleeping time together, 24 hours for each of the 365 days. Whether you believe Jesus' ministry was for just one year or for three, one might believe that they spent 8,760 to 26,280 hours together with Jesus and their fellow Disciples!

While much of that time recorded in the Gospels witnesses to Jesus' preaching, teaching, healing, and performing of miracles, unrecorded times must have included walking, eating, relaxing, and taking naps. Jesus and the Disciples probably noticed each other's preferences, values, mannerisms, strengths, and shortcomings. Even more, I'm sure they witnessed one another growing as Jesus' disciples while witnessing the transformative Kin-dom of G-d in their midst.

We too, as Easter people who believe with great faith in our risen Christ, have opportunities to witness the work of the Holy Spirit in us throughout our shared discipleship. We spend time together and with Christ, witnessing each other's personalities and spiritual growth in active membership and discipleship (Sunday worship, Bible and book studies, communal prayer and devotions, leadership, meals, service, discipling, teaching, etc.).

Depending on your math, to spend as much time together as the Disciples did with one another and with Jesus, a typical Christian would have to spend on average anywhere from 7 years to 43 years (up to 505 years if you only attend Sunday worship). It takes a lot of time to spend together as disciples of Jesus Christ who are continually receiving the Holy Spirit, and it takes a lot of forgiveness while growing in mutual agape love as a discipling Christian community!

Beloved members and friends of First UMC of Honolulu, along with our membership commitment to our shared discipleship through prayer (over the Lord's Prayer), presence (Advent), gifts (Epiphany), and service (Lent), let us commit to our WITNESS of the risen Christ in this Season of Easter.

May we commit to receive the Holy Spirit! May we commit to forgive one another with the grace of G-d! May we commit to GO & TELL the world that Christ is risen! He is risen indeed!




